

Transport Technician

Position Summary:

- Under limited supervision, plans, directs and provides patient care on a particular shift in the transport environment, in accordance with established corporate philosophy, clinical protocols and medical direction
- Relates effectively with other clinicians for continuity of care; maintains satisfactory relations with referring and receiving departments and nursing units



Essential functions include:

- Provides the best possible patient care by planning, organizing and directing patient care during critical care interfacility transport
- Administers medications and intravenous solutions skillfully and correctly; supports and enforces infection control policies and procedures
- Evaluates the performance of personnel using the peer review process with recommendations for appropriate action
- Identifies problems and guides personnel to their solutions; maintains the standards of accurate and complete recording and reporting; maintains professional approach with confidentiality
- Participates in orientation, in-service training for personnel and program safety training

- Current NREMT-P and PA paramedic certifications
- Minimum one year experience performing interfacility transport recommended
- Minimum three years full time (or equivalent part time) experience in emergency response ambulance service recommended
- Current ACLS, PALS and appropriate trauma life support course certification
- Must have current medical command
